U.S. Army Corps of Engineers closes Mallard Point campsites to repair storm damage

Mobile, Ala. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District, Walter F. George Project has closed Mallard Point campsites 1 through 29 in White Oak Creek Campground near Fort Gaines, Ga., to repair electrical problems and damages resulting from a tornado on January. 7.

The project office also changed status of Oakwood Loop campsites 30 through 59 to nonreservable sites for all reservations made after January 18. All current reservations for the Oakwood Loop sites will be honored.
