## Corps Closes Woodruff Dam Lower Pool for 50th anniversary ceremony

Mobile, Ala. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District, will temporarily reroute parking for Lake Seminole visitors who fish in the lower pool area below Jim Woodruff Dam for three days in March.

Visitors will be asked to park in the marked parking area south of the fishing deck March 14-15. This temporary measure will allow the Site Office to erect tents and prepare a stage for the 50th anniversary ceremony March 16. The normal lower pool parking area will reopen March 17.

“Parking for visitors fishing in the lower pool will be located approximately 30 feet south of the normal designated parking area. Tents and a stage will be set up in the normal parking area for the anniversary celebration,” said E. Patrick Robbins, chief, legislative and public affairs. “We regret any inconvenience that it may cause.”

The two-day celebration begins 10.a.m., March 16, with a commemoration ceremony followed by the renaming the project as the Woodruff/Seminole Site.
