2004 Day Use Annual Passes on Sale for U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Lakes

Mobile, Ala. – If you enjoy spending a day at the lake or plan launching your boat for great fishing adventures and want to save money and time, consider purchasing an annual pass that is good at all U.S. Army Corps of Engineers recreation day use areas and boat ramps.

The nationwide chartreuse day use pass went on sale January 16 and costs \$30. One duplicate pass for a second vehicle can be purchased for \$15. The annual passes are valid from January 1 through December 31.

The 2004 passes arrived late, so the Allatoona Lake allowed picnickers and boaters to enjoy the day use areas free during January. However, starting February 1, a properly displayed pass or receipt will be required to use the recreation areas.

Annual passes can be purchased in person or by phone daily between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Allatoona Lake Operations Manager's Office using cash, check, money order or Visa, Mastercard, American Express or Discover credits cards. Call (678) 721-6700 to buy a pass by phone. To receive the Golden Age Passport and Golden Access Passport discounts, passes must be purchased in person at the Allatoona Lake Operations Manager's Office
