NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

PASCAGOULA HARBOR, PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI

Notice is given to mariners that Mike Hook's cutterhead dredge "MISSOURI H" is expected to begin dredging operations in Pascagoula Harbor on or around April 18, 2014. The "MISSOURI H" will perform dredging operations in the Pascagoula River, Upper Sound, Bayou Casotte and Horn Island Pass Channels. The dredge will be disposing into adjacent to channel disposal sites and the Singing River Island Beneficial Use Area. This operation is expected to continue for approximately 4 months. The dredge can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
