

NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

OCEAN SPRINGS, JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

Notice is given mariners that the Jackson County Board of Supervisors' contractor J.E. Borries, Inc. is expected to begin mechanical dredging on December 17, 2014 on the lower end of Upper Davis Bayou. This is the first of three (3) sites that the contractor will be performing work. The other sites are Stark Bayou and Simmons Bayou. The dredged material from these sites will be transported by barges to the Deer Island Beneficial Use Site located just off the Biloxi coast. It is anticipated this work will be performed during daylight periods and all sites are expected to be completed in approximately eleven (11) months. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF- FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
