NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY, FLORIDA

Notice is given to mariners that a submerged obstruction has been reported at approximately Mile 263 of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway. This obstruction is located outside the channel on the south side and reported to be concrete remnants from the levee breach that occurred at this location in 2013. The levee was recently completely repaired. The U.S. Coast Guard has placed a temporary green buoy on the south side of the channel to mark the obstruction.
