NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

BLACK WARRIOR/TOMBIGBEE RIVERS, ALABAMA

Notice is given to mariners that diving operations and underwater construction activities are expected to begin on January 17, 2015 at mile marker 326.6 on the Black Warrior River. This is downstream of Oliver Lock & Dam.

Notice is given to mariners to use extreme caution in this area as divers will be working in the channel at times. Operations are expected to last until February 10, 2015 but are subject to change due to river conditions.

All mariners should contact Oliver Lock & Dam or the BWT/ALA Rivers Project Management Office for the latest conditions and further information. The lock can be contacted on VHF channels 14 and 16, or at 205-758-4860.
