**NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:**

**TOMBIGBEE RIVER, ALABAMA**

The Inland dredge Integrity will dredge the Coffeeville Lock lower approach between October 4th and 11th. In order to efficiently expedite completion of this work, Mariners should expect delays of up to 6 hours per occurrence during these dates. The dredge will work 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and will monitor VHF channel 16. Mariners should not pass without a proper exchange of signals.

Mariners are urged to exercise caution when transiting this area.
