NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY
APALACHICOLA BAY, FLORIDA

Notice is given to mariners that Inland Dredging Company's dredge "KELLY L" is expected to begin maintenance dredging operations on 9 January 2016 at Mile 358.5 in the Apalachicola Bay reach of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway in Florida. Dredging will be performed in the East-West and North-West leg of the bay with the work expected to be completed in approximately one (1) month. The dredge material will be hydraulically placed into open water sites adjacent to the channel.

The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to a number of support vessels. All vessels will be lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
