NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY, FLORIDA

Notice is given to mariners that at an apparent bank failure occurred near Mile 327.7 of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway, at the intersection of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway and Gulf County Canal, near Port St. Joe, Florida. The failure created shoaling in the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway and the Gulf County Canal. Depth restrictions in this area are approximately 5.5 feet on the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway and 2.4 feet on the Gulf County Canal.

The site conditions are still being evaluated and additional information will be provided as it becomes available.
