NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY, FLORIDA

Reference Navigation Bulletin No. 16-17.

Notice is given to mariners that updated hydrographic surveys revealed less shoaling at the site near Mile 327.7 of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW). As a result, the U.S. Coast Guard issued a notice to relax restrictions to vessels in this area only on the GIWW to a draft of 8 feet or less. Shallow depths remain on the Gulf County Canal.
