



GOVERNMENT SHUT DOWN INFORMATION

MOBILE, Ala. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Mobile District has reduced services due to lack of funding legislation for fiscal year 2014 and the current government shutdown.

Impacts on Mobile District

Personnel in public safety and protection of infrastructure-related positions will remain on duty.

Projects Remaining Open

Projects remaining open are: locks and dams; district lands designated for hunting; district lands managed by state agencies; and ongoing construction projects.

Dredging operations will continue as scheduled due to carry-over funding from previous fiscal years.

Closed Projects

District-operated campgrounds, day-use parks and boat ramps will be closed, and off limits, to the public. Campgrounds and other recreational areas operated under leases will remain open. Campers will receive a refund for any unused portion of their reservations.
