FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT FOR THE

**PROPOSED COBB COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BRIDGE
REPLACEMENT AND MINOR ROADWAY REALIGNMENT
ACROSS BUTLER CREEK,
COBB COUNTY, GEORGIA**

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

The Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Proposed Cobb County Department of Transportation Bridge Replacement and Minor Roadway Realignment Across Butler Creek, Tributary of Lake Acworth, Cobb County, Georgia was signed by Colonel Steven J. Roemhildt, P.E., U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District on 28 February 2013.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District proposes to grant an easement to the Cobb County Department of Transportation (CCDOT) for the purpose of replacing the existing Nance Road bridge over Butler Creek with a new bridge and minor shifting of the roadway approaches on new vertical and horizontal alignment to better accommodate 100-year flood events. The easement includes 3.26 acres of permanent easement and 3.08 acres of temporary construction easement. The easement will allow CCDOT to construct and to maintain the new bridge and roadway. In addition, the action includes easements for the relocation of several existing utilities currently located along the Nance Road corridor.
