



BOUNDARY LINE WITNESS TREE MARKINGS



At Allatoona Lake, red paint is used to mark witness trees near the boundary line. Drawings 1, 2, and 3 illustrate the different types of markings and describe their meanings.

1. "CORNER WITNESS TREE"





Tree is painted with three horizontal lines that encircle the trunk. The circle painted below the lines faces the property corner.

2. "LINE WITNESS TREE"



The most common witness tree. Two horizontal lines face the boundary line.

3. "CENTER LINE TREE"



This witness tree is used when the line goes through the tree. A circle is painted on both sides of the trunk.
