West Point Project Hunting Permits Now Available for Purchase

Mobile, Ala.-The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers West Point Project Management Office in West Point Ga. announces today that permits and maps for 2014-2015 hunting seasons are now available. A permit is required to hunt on lands managed by USACE at West Point Project. The permit fee is \$20.

All hunters are encouraged to examine the hunting maps and permits closely to ensure compliance with all rules, regulations, and weapon restrictions. In addition to these rules and regulations, all state hunting regulations also apply for the state in which the permit holder is hunting. The USACE at West Point manages approximately 10,000 acres of land for hunters to utilize. West Point Lake Hunting Permits do not apply to the West Point Wildlife Management Area, which is roughly 10,000 acres as well and is managed by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources.

Permits may be purchased at the West Point Lake Visitors' Center, by telephone at 706-645-2937 using a major credit card, or by mail at the address listed below:
