U.S. Army Corps of Engineers host final workshop on the Butler Creek Ecosystem Restoration Project

Mobile, Ala. -- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Mobile District will host a public workshop Tuesday, Sept. 8 between 6 – 8 p.m. EDT to discuss the Butler Creek Ecosystem Restoration Project.

District employees will present the results from the comprehensive watershed study of Butler Creek, from its headwaters in Kennesaw, Ga. to its tailwaters at Lake Acworth in Acworth, Ga.

“The public is invited to provide comments to complete the feasibility study,” Public Affairs Officer E. Patrick Robbins said.

The public workshop presentations will begin 6 p.m. at the Cobb County Training Facility, Marietta, Ga. After the presentations, technical representatives from the Mobile District and Cobb County Water System will be available to answer questions about the proposed projects.
