## **CORPS OF ENGINEERS DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED TANYARD CREEK PARK LEASE TO CITY OF ACWORTH, GEORGIA**

**Mobile, Ala.**-The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is conducting an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the update of the Master Plan for Tanyard Creek Park.

“The proposed action is the lease of land additional from the Corps to allow the City of Acworth, Georgia to operate and maintain areas adjacent to its current leased area of Tanyard Creek Park, recreation facility that currently includes the Amos Durr softball field, several outbuildings associated with the ball field, an unpaved parking area, and undeveloped wooded park areas for recreational use,” said Lisa Coghlan, Deputy Public Affairs Officer.

“The City of Acworth proposes to add the following amenities in the new leased area: a paved entrance drive and parking area and the construction of a approximately 10-foot wide concrete multi-use trail through the undeveloped portions of the park,” said Coghlan.

The Corps is soliciting comments from the general public, federal, state and local agencies and officials, Indian tribes, and other interest parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of the proposed activity. The Corps
