## **West Point announces an Operational Change at the Dam**

**Mobile, Ala.**— The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, (Corps) at West Point Lake announces an operational change at the Dam. Starting on Oct. 5, the crew at West Point Power Plant will take down Unit one for a biennial inspection. “This is a scheduled two year inspection. The unit should be back on line by Oct.16,” said Lisa Coghlan, Deputy Public Affairs Officer.

“During the inspection a spillway gate will have to be opened to maintain minimum flow into the Chattahoochee River. The Corps will be discharging a continuous minimum flow requirement of 670 cubic feet per second,” said Coghlan.
