## **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to conduct Environmental Assessment for Allatoona Landing Marina**

**Mobile, Ala.** – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Mobile District is conducting a Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) to update the Master Plan for Allatoona Landing Marina, Allatoona Lake, city of Cartersville and Bartow County, Ga. The proposed action includes approval of an updated Master Development Plan showing a combination of existing development and proposed improvements.

“The proposed improvements at the Allatoona Landing Marina include renovation of the maintenance building into a group pavilion area, a new maintenance building, a 600-foot retaining wall, fishing dock, a 300-boat dry stack storage building, a closed loop boat wash system, 221 wet slips on six additional docks and 126 wet slips added to existing docks and 30 cabins and 606 parking spaces in four new parking lots,” Mobile District Deputy Public Affairs Officer Lisa Coghlan said.

Mobile District is soliciting comments from the general public, federal, state and local agencies and officials, and other interest parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of the proposed activity. Any comments received will be used to determine whether or not to proceed with the proposed action.
