NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

BLACK WARRIOR AND TOMBIGBEE RIVER SYSTEM, ALABAMA

The dredge MISSOURI H will continue work downriver from Coffeetown after recession of current high river stages. The dredge monitors VHF radio channels 3 and 16.

ALABAMA RIVER SYSTEM ALABAMA

The dredge E STROUD is continuing work below Claiborne and monitors VHF radio channels 6 and 16.

Current surveys on the Alabama River indicate the following available depths with a Claiborne tailwater reading of 7.9 feet:

| 34 | Red Eagle | 8 |
| 47 | Shackleford | 8 |
| 59 | Pigeon Creek | 8 |
