NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY **MISSISSIPPI**

Notice is given to mariners that recent heavy rainfall has created shoaling at Mile 362.6 in Aberdeen Lake. Width restriction in this area is approximately 140 feet. Shoaling also exists at Mile 366.0 of Aberdeen Lake, where width restriction is approximately 130 feet. Temporary buoys have been placed at both sites to mark good water.

Tenn-Tom Project Office's motor vessel TENN-TOM and floating plant R.W. Davis is expected to mobilize to Mile 362.6 on February 18, 2004 and begin excavation work. Upon completion of work at this site, the floating plant will move to Mile 366.0 to perform work.

The floating plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
