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## **New Walter F. George Hunting Permit and Fees**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at the Apalachicola, Chattahoochee, Flint (ACF) Project Management Office in Fort Gaines GA, announced that hunting permits for the 2008/2009 season will be available starting August 1, 2008. The permits are required in addition to state licenses, to hunt on lands managed by the Corps at Walter F. George Lake. Each permit requires the permit holder's name and address. The permits will include maps indicating lands available for hunting and a survey sheet to record area/game harvested.

This year, there will be a fee of \$15.00 for each permit, to cover the administrative cost of the program, including the cost to print the permits and maps. There are 6 areas on the project open for hunting, not including WMAs managed by the State of Alabama and Georgia.

Permits will be available beginning Friday, August 1, 2008, and may be obtained in person at Walter F. George Visitor's Center or by mail at the following address.

To obtain a permit, hunters must send a self-addressed and stamped business class (no. 10) envelope with a note indicating the envelope is for a hunting permit. Hunters must include their phone numbers on the note. Persons requesting a Walter F. George Hunting Permit must provide their name, mailing address, telephone number and state hunting permit number. Checks and money orders should be made out to: F&A Officer, USACE, do not send cash.
