Biography

Mr. L. Douglas Turney serves as the Deputy District Engineer for Programs and Project Management for the Mobile District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. He is responsible for programmatic oversight of the planning, design and construction of Military, Civil Works, Environmental, and Support for Others (SFO) projects for the District. These services support fifteen major military installations and numerous water resources programs in five southeastern states and twelve countries in Central and South America. All programs managed total approximately one billion dollars annually. He assumed his current position in January 2001.

His previous position was Director, Programs Management Division, Missouri River Division and Northwestern Division in Omaha, Nebraska. Other prior positions include Deputy, Programs and Project Management Division, Tulsa District; Eastern Area Engineer, Fort Worth District; the Deputy Director for Engineering and Housing at Headquarters VII Corps, Stuttgart, Germany. He previously served in public works positions in Karlsruhe, Goepingen, and Aschaffenburg, Germany. He began his career with the Department of Army as Chief, Environmental Programs, Fort Hood, Texas.

Mr. Turney earned a Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Arkansas and two Master of Science Degrees in Environmental and Civil Engineering from the University of Oklahoma. He is a registered professional engineer.
