U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District, holds public hearing concerning proposed marina in Little Lagoon, Gulf Shores, Ala.

Mobile, Ala. – The Mobile District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will hold a public hearing to gather public comments on the proposed marina in Little Lagoon in Gulf Shores, Ala.

The hearing will be held Tuesday, June 29, 2004, at the Erie H. Meyer Civic Center, 1930 West Second Street, Gulf Shores, Ala. The hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. Anyone wishing to speak should arrive no later than 5:45 p.m. to register.

“This public hearing is being held to help identify significant issues and to receive public input and comment,” said Pat Robbins, Chief Legislative and Public Affairs. “We invite full public participation to promote open communication on the issues surrounding this proposal. Participation by Federal, State, and local agencies, and other interested organizations is also encouraged.”

The corps representatives will accept verbal and written statements at the hearing.

The corps will consider all comments received at the hearing to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. Comments are used in the preparation of Environmental Assessments and Environmental Impact Statements pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the overall public interest in the proposed activity.
