**Public Notice of Public Workshop for Draft Environmental Impact
Statement for the Foley Land Cut Portion of the Gulf Intracoastal
Waterway Gulf Shores and Orange Beach, Alabama**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) and the cities of Gulf Shores and Orange Beach, Ala. will conduct a Public Workshop on March 24, 2009 to solicit input on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Foley Land Cut Portion of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway, Gulf Shores and Orange Beach, Ala. The Foley Land Cut Portion of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway is located between Oyster Bay and Wolf Bay. The purpose of the Public Workshop is to seek public input on issues or concerns relevant to the DEIS.

The public is invited to comment on the activities surrounding the proposed waterfront development along the Foley Land Cut Portion of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway in Baldwin County, Ala. Federal, state, and local agencies, federally recognized tribes, individuals, and organizations that have an interest are urged to participate.
