For your review and comment, enclosed is the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (DSEIS) for the proposed Bienville Offshore Energy Terminal (BOET) Deepwater Port License Application (Docket Number USCG-2006-24644). The DSEIS is for the amended BOET application which proposes the use of a "closed-loop" LNG vaporization system known as ambient air vaporization (AAV) in place of the "open-loop" vaporization system proposed in the original application. Your comments will be considered in the development of the Final Supplemental EIS.
