ELECTRICAL - APPROVAL AND QUALIFICATIONS

The 15 September 2008 Safety Manual (yellow book) is now in effect for most new contracts and government operations. Please note the requirements for electrical as stated below.

11.A.01 Approval and qualification. The term “Qualified Person”, as used in this section, refers to “Qualified Person, Electrical”. > **See Appendix Q.**

a. All electrical wiring and equipment shall be a type listed by a nationally recognized testing laboratory for the specific application for which it is to be used.

b. All electrical work shall comply with applicable National Electrical Safety Code (NESC), National Electric Code (NEC), OSHA and USCG regulations.

c. Electrical work shall be performed by Qualified Personnel with verifiable credentials who are familiar with applicable code requirements. Verifiable credentials consist of State, National and/or Local Certifications or Licenses that a Master or Journeyman Electrician may hold, depending on work being performed, and should be identified in the appropriate AHA.

(1) USACE and/or other Government designated electricians having attained Journeyman Level qualification via completion of USACE/Government-sponsored electrical training programs are considered to be in compliance with this requirement.

(2) Journeyman/Apprentice ratio shall be in accordance with State, Local and Host Nation requirements applicable to where work is being performed.
