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Required Registrations (Obtain Registrations in the Order Shown)

1. Get an NCAGE Code assigned - <https://eportal.nspa.nato.int/Codification/CageTool/request-new-cage> - It takes up to 14 business days to obtain an NCAGE code.
2. Create a SAM account and get your Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) Number (formally known as DUNS) at www.sam.gov. Allow up to 15 business days after submission before your registration is active in SAM.
