As provided in Section XXII of the Defense Depot Memphis Tennessee (DDMT) Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA), the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) hereby requests an extension for the BRAC Cleanup Plan (BCP), V13, Rev. 0. An extension of 20 days is requested, which will change the submittal date of 1 December to 21 December 2009. This extension will result in a corresponding delay to submittal of the BCP, Rev. 1, from 29 January to 18 February 2010.
