Re: Request for Permit Exemption for Two (2) Soil Remediation Systems (Source# 01030-01P) and Cancellation of Permit

Dear Ms. Jones:

In a letter dated 6, 2016, this Department received information and data concerning the two permitted soil remediation systems located at the Defense Depot Memphis, Tennessee.

From information obtained in the letter it appears that the **uncontrolled** emissions from this source are below the threshold limit for an exemption.

This Department is canceling permit 1030 and exempting the soil remediation system in accordance with the City of Memphis Code 16-77, reference State of Tennessee Code 1200-3-9.04(4)(d)(8), which provides an exemption for any process emission source emitting less than 0.1 pounds per hour of a pollutant.

It is recommended that a periodically review the emissions data from the source to ensure the emissions are less than the 0.1 lbs/hr limit required for exemption status.
