## **MAIN INSTALLATION**

**Remedial Action** - No current remedial action

### **Supplemental Remedial Investigation (SRI)/Focused Feasibility Study (FFS)**

SRI Phase 2 Work Plan approved by TDEC on 29 June. EPA granted preliminary approval of proposed well locations on 29 June with complete review and comments from EPA due by 5 August. Mr. Holmes stated that Ms. Hutton is working with Land Group out of USACE Mobile for execution of access agreements and no issues are expected.

## **DUNN FIELD**

**Remedial Action** - FSVE system shut down in 2012. AS/SVE system operating.

Mr. Holmes stated that the SVE manifold remains closed and will be opened this week. Quarterly vapor sampling and monitoring at SVE wells and VMPs will be performed next week, on 18-20 July. Kaeser inspected Blower #1 and has provided a quote for repairs/modifications.

Air Sparge Well Installation Work Plan submitted for internal review on 1 July and scheduled for regulatory review on 8 August. Mr. Calhoun stated that in order to optimize the field effort to coincide with SRI well installations, preliminary approval of the AS well locations may be requested once Memphis Light, Gas and Water has provided distance tolerances from transmission towers.

Mr. Calhoun stated that the MIP Survey Work Plan was submitted for internal review on 1 July and scheduled for regulatory review on 15 August. Ms. Lloyd inquired about schedule for field visit and after review of current schedule, work is planned to begin week of 7 November. Team agreed to provide updates as document approvals progress.

## **LONG TERM MONITORING**

Mr. Holmes stated that the April 2016 LTM report is due for internal review by 15 July. As previously discussed, higher water levels were observed in April. Mr. Holmes will update the precipitation/ water level data initially presented in the April 2015 LTM report..

## **OTHER ISSUES**

Ms. Hutton stated that two calls had been received on the Community Information Line in the month of June. One call was in reference to claims and the other call was interested in how to obtain copies of documents.

Mr. Holmes stated that he had received the Internal Draft Annual LUC inspection report for review.

Ms. Hutton stated that the 2017 contracting effort had been initiated.
