GENERAL

Mr. Woods stated that he had received calls from local residents requesting information concerning health claims related to DDMT and has provided the contact information for Mr. McGee at Ft. Campbell. Ms. Jones suggested discussion be limited to providing the contact information in order to avoid conflicts with Mr. McGee as Ft. Campbell is responsible for judging claims related to DDMT.

MAIN INSTALLATION

Remedial Action - No current remedial action

Supplemental Remedial Investigation (SRI)/Focused Feasibility Study (FFS)

SRI Phase 2 Work Plan response to EPA comments submitted by Ms. Hutton on 4 August for concurrence.

Mr. Holmes stated that access agreements have been executed for two additional off-site wells with the final agreement expected soon.

DUNN FIELD

Remedial Action - FSVE system shut down in 2012. AS/SVE system operating.

Mr. Holmes stated that the SVE manifold will be closed during the week of 8 August and will remain closed until mid-September. Analytical data received for 1st quarter vapor samples collected in July and will be evaluated; the data will be presented in the semiannual report.

As a result of the July inspection on Blower #1 performed by Kaeser, recommendations and estimate for repair/replacement have been provided to the Army for review.

Mr. Holmes stated that Year 5 Report responses to EPA comments were submitted on 5 July for concurrence. He acknowledged an email from Ms. Lloyd that the responses were recently provided to TechLaw for review. Ms. Lloyd stated the review was not expected to take long based on the limited number of comments.

Mr. Calhoun stated that comments on Internal Draft Air Sparge Well Installation Work Plan were received through 3 August and responses will be returned by 12 August for concurrence. Revised delivery of Draft Air Sparge Well Installation Work Plan for regulatory review is now on or before 18 August. Communication continues with Memphis Light, Gas and Water for distance tolerances from transmission towers for final AS well locations.

Mr. Calhoun stated that comments on Internal Draft MIP Survey Work Plan were received through 8 August and responses will be returned by 17 August for concurrence. Revised delivery date of Draft MIP Survey Work Plan for regulatory review is now on or before 23 August.

LONG TERM MONITORING

Mr. Holmes stated that comments from EPA on the 2015 LTM Report were received 5 August and responses have been submitted to Army for review. The April 2016 LTM report is in Army review.

OTHER ISSUES

LUC Annual Report Rev. 0 submitted to Ms. Lloyd and Mr. Woods on 2 August for review.

Base Map Update provided for internal review on 27 July with responses received on 9 August. Final Base Map Update will be issued by 16 August.

Mr. Holmes stated that work on the Sitewide Generic UFP-QAPP had begun and is expected to be completed in October for use in 2016 annual reports. The revision will utilize the optimized worksheets.

Mr. Holmes stated that preparation of the Site Management Plan is scheduled to start at the beginning of September.
