SUBJECT: Defense Distribution Depot Memphis, Draft Interim
Holding Facility Plan, 24 August 1995

1. As agreed to at the 27 February 1995 Defense Depot Memphis, Tennessee (DDMT) Chemical Warfare Management Plan planning meeting, please find enclosed the subject Interim Holding Facility Plan. To support the project strategy developed at this meeting the subject document will be included with your normal site safety documentation due to the remote possibility of uncovering Chemical Agent Identification Set materiel during the remediation of the sanitary areas of Dunn Field. If the current remediation plans are expanded to include suspect Chemical Warfare Materiel (CWM) burial areas of Dunn Field a Department of the Army approved Safety Submission will be required.
2. Based on the 14 March 1995, CH2M Hill memorandum, subject: Chemical Warfare Management Plan, request verification that DDMT has provided the DDMT Restoration Advisory Board with a list of viable remediation alternatives for Dunn Field to review and approve. In addition, please provide documentation indicating that CWM on-site regulatory storage issues at DDMT have been discussed and resolved with the State of Tennessee. With regard to surety issues, Army Regulation 50-6 has been published and therefore a waiver will not be required.
3. To assist our project planning, please provide a copy of your updated field work schedule along with any comments or concerns by 29 September 1995.

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
