Dear Mr. Chumney:

We are in receipt of the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Revised Final Work Plans, prepared for Defense Depot Memphis by Law Environmental, Inc., and dated April 1989. Please be advised that the lead Federal organization for hazardous waste activities will be the RCRA Branch, Waste Management Division, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region IV. In addition, as Tennessee is authorized for the base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) program, and as Defense Depot Memphis is not on the National Priorities List, the Tennessee Department of Health and Environment (TDHE) will be your primary contact for RCRA activities not related directly to solid waste management unit corrective action and for State Superfund matters. It will be necessary for your facility to comply with all RCRA requirements in regard to such hazardous waste permitting and compliance actions as the RCRA Facility Assessment (RFA), RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI), and corrective action.

We are currently making arrangements to conduct a RFA of Defense Depot Memphis. You will be contacted in the future by our contractor, who will arrange with you a date on which the site investigation may be conducted. Based on the recommendations resulting from the RFA, a RFI may be required. In that event, we will review your submitted RI/FS Work Plan and inform you of any additional information needed to comply with the requirements of a RFI Work Plan.
