PUBLIC REVIEW OF FINDING OF SUITABILITY TO TRANSFER

March 25 - April 26, 2004

Notification of the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) and the Department of the Army's intent to execute one Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST #3) for surplus property at the former Defense Distribution Depot Memphis, Tennessee.

The property proposed for transfer consists of 65 buildings, 37.45 acres of recreational property, and 249.21 acres of open land areas (including open storage areas, paved and grassed areas around buildings). The property is intended for transfer to the Memphis Depot Redevelopment Corporation (DRC) and is consistent with the intended reuse of the property as set forth in the *Memphis Depot Redevelopment Plan*. It is also consistent with Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Section 120(h) and Department of Defense policy.
