PUBLIC REVIEW OF FINDING OF SUITABILITY TO TRANSFER January 24 - February 23, 2005

Notification of the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) and the Department of the Army's intent to execute one Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST #4) for surplus property at the former Defense Distribution Depot Memphis, Tennessee.

The property is intended for transfer as a public benefit conveyance (PBC) through the Department of Interior for recreational use and through the Department of Transportation for light industrial and commercial use consistent with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Section 120(h), Department of Defense policy and the Depot Redevelopment Corporation's Memphis Depot Redevelopment Plan.
