Dear Col. Kennedy

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act and the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act, the Defense Depot Concerned Citizens' Committee (DEMT-COC) requests all files, records, documents, and diagrams relating to the operation and duties of the Chemical Warfare Service from 1942 to 1996.

DOMT-COC also requests you disclose all information about buildings, areas, and dates chemical warfare weapons were received, stored, manufactured, and/or shipped to or from the Defense Depot. In addition, DDMT-COC requests information of spills, wastes, and burials. Specifically, DDMT-COC requests names of chemical warfare weapons tested or manufactured by the Defense Depot.

DDMT-COC has in its possession a document that reveals that a Chemical Warfare Service (unit) existed and operated on the Defense Depot, that specialized chemical trains delivered chemicals to designated chemical warfare buildings, and that open areas of the Defense Depot were used for specialized chemical warfare operations.

If you choose to deny this request, in any part, I would like to know exactly what is being denied, and the basis under the law for such a denial. We request a written response of any denial.

Defense Depot Memphis Tennessee - Concerned Citizens' Committee (DOMT-COC) is a non-profit grassroots organization devoted to fighting environmental injustice wreaked upon black communities by white corporations and military facilities and to protecting the environment and public health from toxic hazards.

- 4) No "specialized" use of any of the documents is contemplated at this time.
