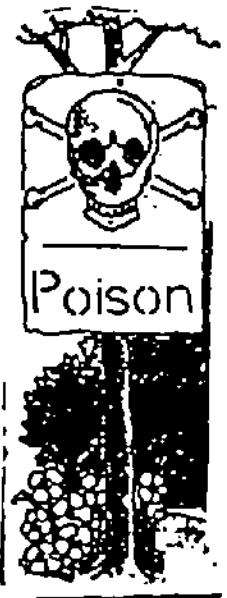

Dear Col. Kennedy;

In review of the Federal Facilities Agreement, DDMT-CCC learned the following in the section entitled "Administrative Record & Public Participation:

- D. DLA agrees it shall establish and maintain an official Administrative Record for each OU, which will include an index of all documents contained therein in accordance with Section 113 (k) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C., Section 9613 (k) at the Main Library.

Pursuant to the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act, DDMT-CCC requests a copy of the Administrative Record for OU-2, OU-3, and OU-4.

In addition, DDMT-CCC makes a formal complaint against the Defense Depot for combining groundwater contamination and buried hazardous waste for OU-1. The plume of contamination, because of severity, should have its own separate designation (OU). And, because the groundwater contamination is located off the boundary of the Defense Depot, leaching and perching contamination necessitates the posting of NPL Superfund Site poison signs to warn innocent black residents of the strong possibility of being exposed to toxins.
