Dear Mr. Kaden:

The Tennessee Division of Superfund, Memphis Field Office (MFO), on behalf of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC/DSF), reviewed the above-referenced document received in this office September 15, 1997. Your 9/15/97 cover letter requested review and comment on this Plan by 9/24/97. TDEC/DSF has the following comments.

Section 1.0, page 1-1, third paragraph:

Lake Danielson is incorrectly referred to as Lake Davidson in this paragraph.

Section 4.1, page 4-1, second paragraph:

Because of the implications in the last paragraph of this section (see next comment), please clarify why electrofishing cannot be utilized, if necessary.

Section 4.1, page 4-2, last paragraph:

Although it seems unlikely that the suggested methods for fish sampling will be totally unsuccessful, determination of whether there is a fish population in the pond may require additional steps if no fish are actually collected. If fish are in the pond, actual data are required for the Risk Assessment. If there are no fish in the pond, that fact should be confirmed.
