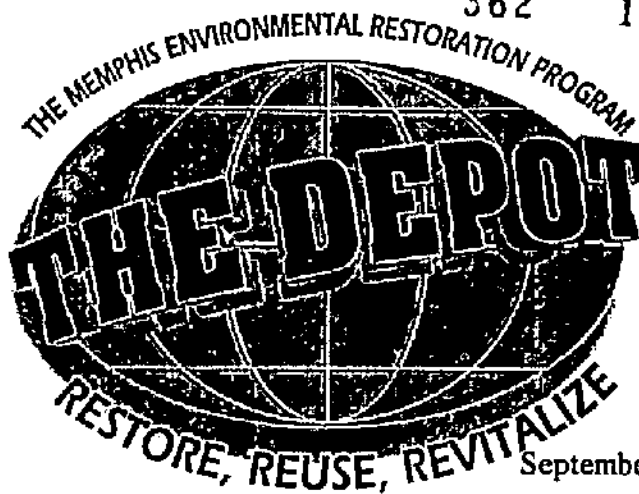

**TO: Residents of Rivertown Square Apartments****UPDATE: Soil Removal at the Depot's Family Housing Area**

As part of the Depot's cleanup program, we are continuing to remove surface soil at the Depot's Family Housing Area. We informed you of our cleanup plans in July and we expect this family housing cleanup project should last 2 more months. The pesticide (Dieldrin) in the soil that was applied years ago to control insects is no longer used. Based on the presence of this pesticide that was used years ago, the top 6 to 12 inches of soil is being removed from the depot housing area and then trucked to an approved off-site landfill for disposal.

We have asked our contractor, OHM Remediation Services, to put up plastic along the fence throughout the remainder of this project to help minimize the dust. We appreciate the patience that you have shown with the dust during the past weeks.

After the family housing area is complete, we will turn the area over to an appropriate agency that will provide housing for homeless families. These efforts are all a part of the Depot's commitment to restore, reuse and revitalize this facility.

Our next Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting is October 15th at 6 p.m. in Building 144 at the Depot. Park at Gate 1 and enter through the side doors. This will be our last RAB meeting for the year. These meetings are open to the public and we encourage participation from all of the community.
