(October, 1998) As part of the Depot's ongoing cleanup program, groundwater is being sampled at several off-site locations in the Depot community. Work began late September and will be completed by November 30, 1998. The off-site locations are near the following intersections-Corry & Norris, Person & Rozelle, the fenceline of Dunn School, Sparks & Mallory, Sparks & Ball, Manchester & Kingsview and Ketchum & Ball. The purpose of the groundwater sampling is to monitor the quality of the groundwater in the Depot area The information gained from the sampling efforts will be used to evaluate alternatives for cleanup.

The work is being conducted by the Depot's contractor, CH2M Hill They will be working long days, so you will likely see them from sunup to sundown. A local drilling company will join the sampling team because soil borings will be drilled to gather samples anywhere from 10 feet to 40 feet deep.

Don't be surprised if you see the team out on Saturdays and Sundays. Once their work begins, it is common practice to work until the assignment is complete. The team will work to schedule their weekend activities in the interior of the Main Installation of the Depot to lessen the disturbances to you

These sampling efforts are all a part of the Depot's commitment to restore, reuse and revitalize this facility. We encourage you to attend community meetings and call us with input or suggestions. Our next Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting is Thursday, January 21, 1998 at 6 p m in the Conference Room, Building 144 at the Depot. Park at Gate 1 and enter through the side door.
