



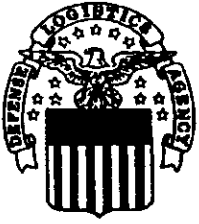

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC MEETING AT MEMPHIS DEPOT

(Memphis, June 16, 1999) The Memphis Depot will hold a public comment meeting on Thursday June 17, 1999, to allow citizens the opportunity to provide comments on the proposed cleanup alternative for the Chemical Warfare Materiel (CMW) removal at Dunn Field. This area is surrounded by Dunn, Hays, Rozelle and Person streets. Technical presentations by the project contractors will outline the environmental condition of the area and factors considered in the review of the removal alternatives.

Prior to the presentations and official comment meeting, the Depot environmental staff, CWM project managers and contractors, community support organizations and representatives from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) will be available between 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. to address individual questions.

The meeting is one method of providing for public input during the 30-calendar-day public comment period for the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for this project, which began on June 10, 1999. The EE/CA is a document that describes the environmental condition of an area and provides cleanup alternatives. This EE/CA is available for public review at Information Repositories, which include the Memphis Depot, Cherokee Branch Library, Main Branch Library and the Memphis/Shelby County Health Department.

The public may also respond with comments in writing to Mr. Shawn Phillips, Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Environmental Coordinator at the Depot, or provide verbal comments to this EE/CA through the Depot's Environmental Information Line at (901) 544-0618.

The Depot will respond to public comments in a written summary that will be available at each of the Information Repositories.
