Residents to be told of depot work

Contractors and base officials today will outline their plans for removing buried chemical-warfare agents — including neutralized German mustard gas bombs — from the old Defense Depot Memphis.

The facility at 2163 Airways will host a series of meetings aimed at informing nearby residents about the project. The first session will be a 4 p.m. "community availability" event in which residents can get one-on-one assistance from officials.

The base Restoration Advisory Board will have a public

meeting at 6 p.m., followed by a technical presentation on the chemical warfare material. The sessions will conclude with a public comment meeting scheduled to begin at 7:30 p.m.
