### **Spotlighting on the Defense Depot Memphis Restoration Advisory Board**

In July 1994 soon after the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) determined that the Depot required environmental cleanup, the Depot formed a review group made up of federal, state and local environmental and health representatives as well as nine community members. This group became the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) and was operating before the Department of Defense (DOD) and the EPA issued policy and guidance to implement the program at military bases selected for closure.

The DOD has successfully established over 40 RABs throughout the country and is committed to continuously improving the community's involvement and trust in the decision making process regarding restoration and closure action.

RAB members meet the third Thursday of every month to review and comment on plans and activities at the Defense Depot Memphis. These meetings are open to the public. The next meetings are scheduled for July 16<sup>th</sup> and August 20<sup>th</sup> beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the Depot.
