This letter is in response to your request for the Defense Distribution Center (DDC) to host an online information repository for the former Defense Depot, Memphis, Tennessee.

After a thorough review of the applicable laws governing public access to information and the resources required to maintain a comprehensive online repository, we are unable to approve your request. However, I am pleased to inform you that, as a member of the Memphis Depot Restoration Advisory Board (RAB), you will soon have access to technical reports on CD-ROM. Our goal is to have these electronic reports available within the next few months.

Our commitment to providing the Memphis Depot community with convenient access to reports and administrative records relating to the environmental program goes beyond the requirements of federal laws and Department of Defense (DoD) policies. The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) currently maintains four information repositories in the community. In addition, DLA provides regular updates on cleanup activities and summaries of key technical reports through the existing website, community newsletters, presentations and RAB meetings.

We appreciate your ongoing interest and support of the restoration program at the former Memphis Depot, and we will continue our commitment to ensure that you and all members of the community have full and open access to information throughout the process.
