## What is a 5-Year Review?



- The 5-Year Review requirement applies to remedial actions selected under CERCLA where the remedy does not allow for unrestricted reuse
  - *Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA)*
- Required every five years after the start of a remedial action

## What is a 5-Year Review? (cont'd)



- Pump and discharge system installed at Dunn Field in January 1998 as an Interim Remedial Action
  - therefore a 5-year review due January 2003
- Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) is responsible for conducting the review and providing the information to Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) and the community

## What is its purpose?



- To determine if the selected remedial action continues to:
  - be protective of human health and the environment
  - meet the objectives identified within the Record of Decision

## What is the process?



- The 5-Year Review is divided into four stages:
  1. Planning
    - Includes notification to regulators, community, other stakeholders
  2. Information Collection
    - Site inspection
    - Document review
    - Stakeholder interviews
  3. Technical evaluation and conclusions
  4. Report
    - Draft will be reviewed by EPA & TDEC

## **What is the process? (cont'd)**



- Results will be presented in a report that will be available for public review in Depot's information repositories

## **How is the community involved in the process?**



- Notification at the start of a 5-Year Review process
- Information updates about Review process (EnviroNews)
- Notification of the completion of the 5-Year Review process and placement of report in Depot's Information Repositories
