Dear Mr. Deback

The site schedule approved for the Memphis Depot cleanup under the Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) called for submittal to EPA and the State of a CERCLA Feasibility Study (FS) on February 2, 2002. I understand that part of the delay is associated with last-minute changes in the scope of the document agreed to by the BRAC Cleanup Team (BCT), but the Depot did not submit a timely request for a schedule extension under the FFA.

We have discussed this non-compliance informally several times. I have worked with you and your contractor in June to develop a schedule that conforms to the timelines agreed upon in the FFA. Based on our discussions at that time, I expected to receive a revised schedule soon thereafter, along with an explanatory letter and request for acceptance of the new schedule by EPA. I also expected to receive the FS on July 12, 2002. Unfortunately, I have seen nothing to date
