TDEC has reviewed the above referenced document. TDEC finds this report acceptable for its intended purposes. Further, TDEC agrees with the recommendations noted in the report for installing additional monitor wells down gradient of the PCP Dip Vat (\$\$42 and \$\$543) in order to confirm that PCP leachate is not affecting groundwater; and secondly, a digging restriction be included on the deed for this parcel to protect future industrial workers from elevated PCP soil concentrations 10 feet below land surface.
