General Comments:

This document is a marked improvement over previous drafts of the Proposed Plan (Plan). The Tennessee Division of Superfund (TDSF) has a limited number of specific comments which, when addressed, will allow TDSF to concur with the Plan.

Specific Comments:

- 1. Page 5, Alternative response actions--Plume containment is the response action that is actually being retained. Pump and treat is simply a technology used to implement the alternative(s).
- 2. Page 9, 1st paragraph--Please insert "above" before "...their respective...".
