Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) hereby provides notification that mobilization for the Early Implementation of Selected Remedy west of Dunn Field has begun. The remedial action contractor, MACTEC Engineering and Consulting, and their subcontractor for zero-valent iron (ZVI) injection, ARS Technologies, Inc., had personnel arrive at the site Monday November 15, 2004 to begin final preparations for the remedial action. The initial ZVI shipments to DDMT have been received and shipments are expected to be completed by November 17, 2004. ARS's subcontract driller and nitrogen gas supplier are expected to mobilize all equipment to the site November 17, 2004. ZVI injection is to begin November 18, 2004.
